

**COUNCIL BILL NO. 2015- 116**

**ORDINANCE NO.**

AN ORDINANCE approving a contract with Emery Sapp & Sons in the amount of Seven Hundred Forty Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty Seven and 57/100 Dollars (\$748,827.57) for the 32nd Street & Arizona Avenue Regional Detention Basin project in the City of Joplin, Missouri providing how the cost shall be made and levied, and containing an emergency clause;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN as follows:

Section 1. That the contract be awarded Emery Sapp & Sons in the amount of Seven Hundred Forty Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty Seven and 57/100 Dollars (\$748,827.57) for the 32nd Street & Arizona Avenue Regional Detention Basin project.

Section 2. Upon the final approval and acceptance of the contractor’s work under said contract in writing by the Director of Public Works, and his certification to that effect to the Director of Finance, the contractor shall be paid from the Infrastructure Improvements, Account Number 130-4555-530-8665 Project number GSTA03. The project will be reimbursed as a State DED project.

Section 3. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Joplin with said contractor.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12 (6) in that said ordinance provides for public improvements and is considered an emergency by the Council and as such shall become effective immediately upon this passage as provided by the Home Rule Charter for the City of Joplin. Specifically, this ordinance approves construction to begin immediately in the optimal construction time during the calendar year, and appropriations for this contract have been approved by the 2014-2015 budget.
