

Minutes of the October 9, 2019
Regular Meeting of the Citizen's Task Force

CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the October 9, 2019 Citizen's Task Force was called to order by Co- Chair Chuck Copple at 4:30 p.m.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Warren Turner, second by Ken Copeland to approve the September 25 minutes. Motion passed.

Discussion of Proposition "B": Erin Slifka stated that the canvassing/media day on October 2 was successful. The group shared information from the outcome of that day and discussed future opportunities to do this. It was mentioned for the Citizen's Task Force to reach out to the local running groups, contact the directors of these groups, to get gain their support.

She stated both Chief's will be writing one jointly, maybe the second one could come from the Citizen's committee and the third one would be from the Mayor.

Lynn mentioned that the public information meeting at the Library is Tuesday October 15th from 5:30-6:30-she encouraged people from the Citizen's Task Force to come to this event.


